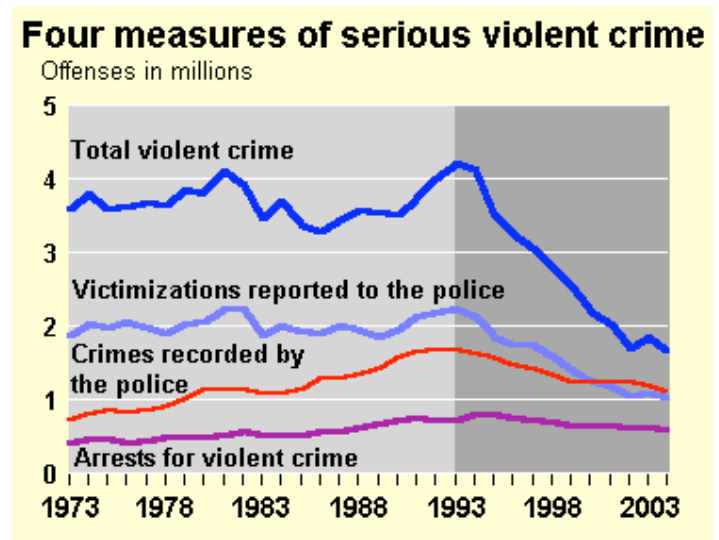
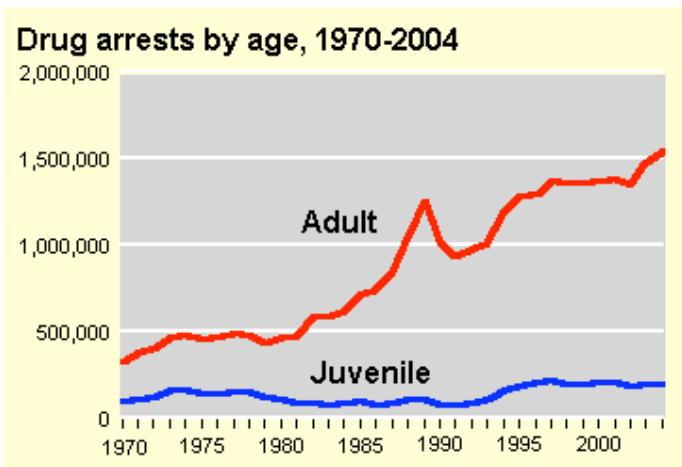

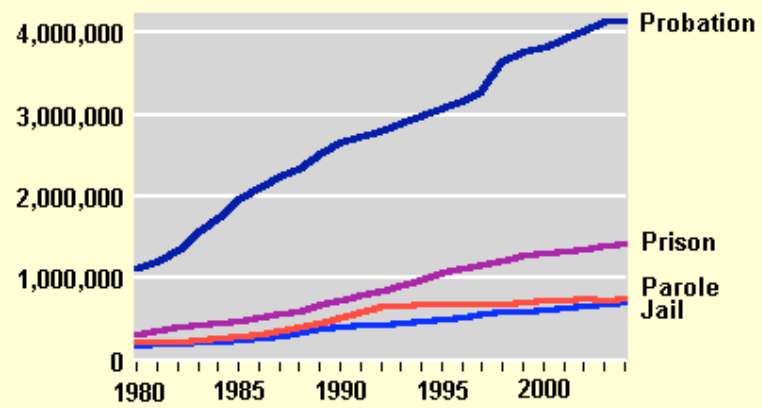

# What is the goal of the criminal justice system?

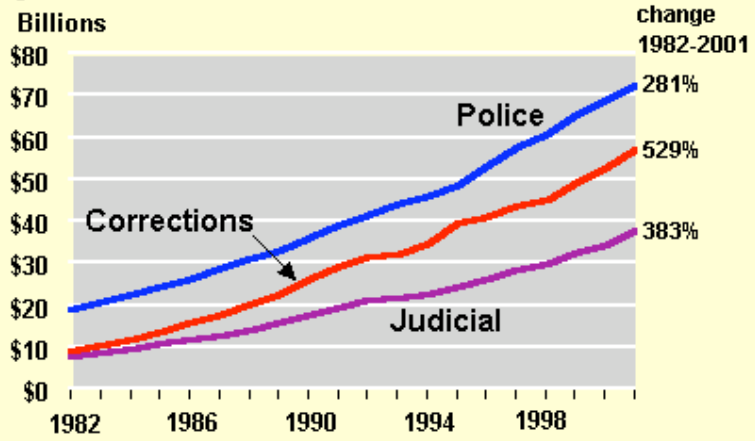
- Punishment

- Rehabilitation



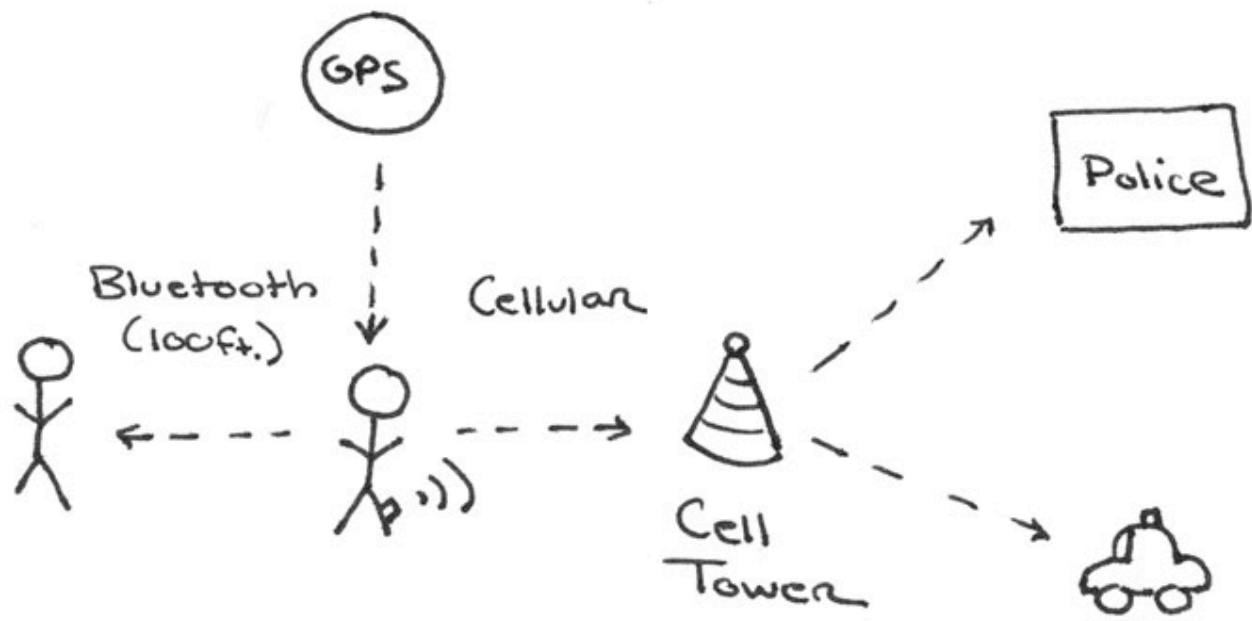
Adult correctional populations, 1980-2004

# The Good

- Criminals forced to spend sentence in a productive manner (college, job, etc.)
- State/ city will save money
- Give criminals opportunity to interact with people who may be a positive influence
- Chance for criminals to be integrated back into society

# The Bad

- Opens up to possible prejudice/ refusal of services
- Whose job is it to punish anyway, individual citizens or the criminal justice system
- “Scarlet Letter Effect”
- May be unconstitutional
